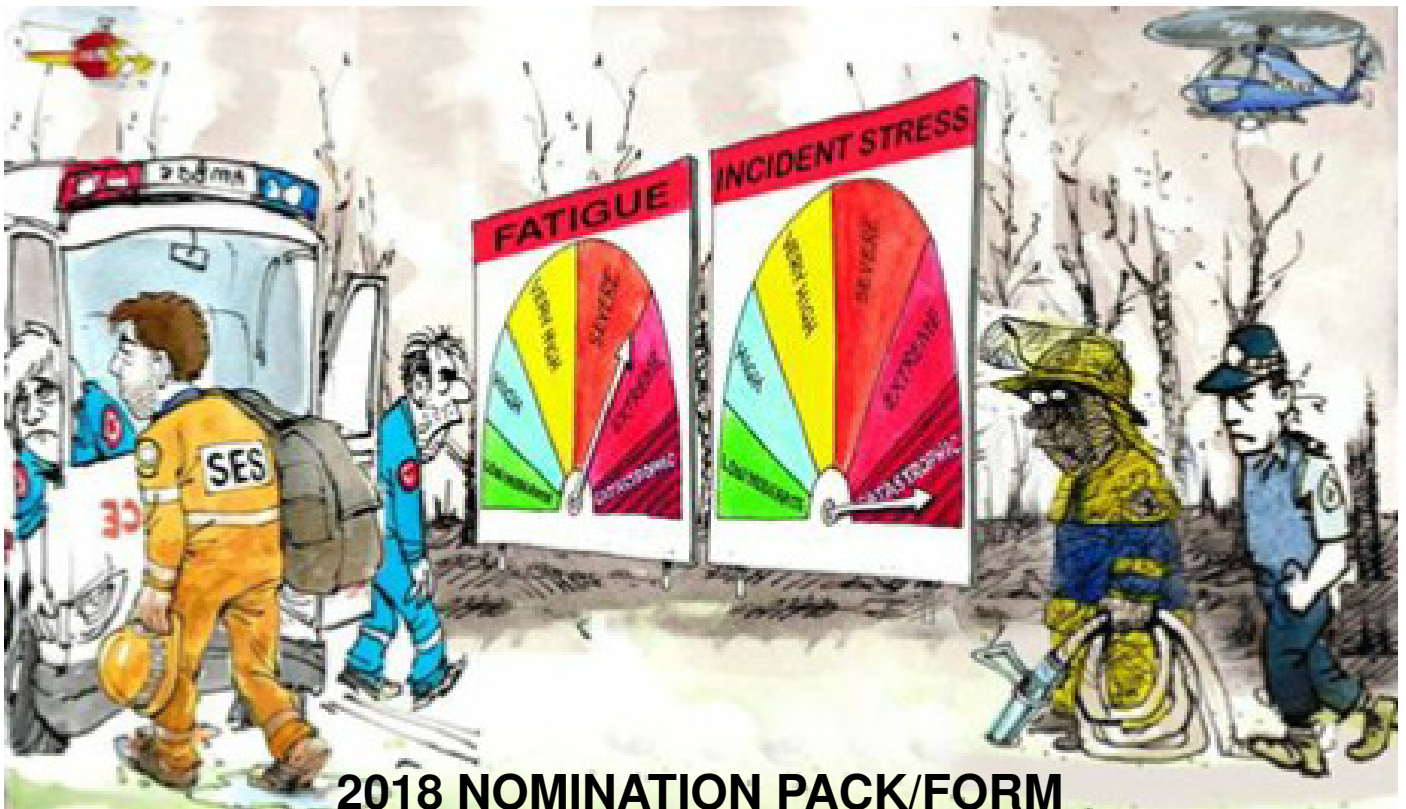

- Types of challenges they have overcome
- Is seen by the community as an essential asset in the life of the local area – explain – see Nomination Form information below, especially Part 4.

Part 3 – Current role in Emergency Services Agency, eg

NSW Fire and Rescue – paid capacity

NSW State Emergency Service – volunteer capacity

Current duties – if unsure, leave for the Emergency Agency to check.

Part 4 - Details about the nominee and how s/he demonstrates Community Service that supports Rotary's "Service Above Self".

NOTE – this is the CRITERIA the panel of judges will focus on – the following CHECKLIST is provided as a guide for each, eg – address the 'why' and provide as many points as you can to highlight 'why', proceed in a similar manner for the remainder.

- Why** you think this officer should receive this award
- How** long s/he has been serving in this Emergency Service Agency – give details of about what s/he has done, eg dates, duration/s,
- What** – current role – what s/he does, eg where s/he started and what she is currently doing
- Where** – add locations, divisions, etc
- Who** – explain about the people s/he serves with and the community that s/he is involved.
- Which** – information you want to highlight/summarise, the important points/reasons why this officer, paid/volunteer has demonstrated community service/service above self - **above and beyond the call of her/his normal duties.**
- Additional information may be provided in supporting documentation such as media clipping/s if provided to assist you to complete the nomination.
