

Rotary International length of Service Recognition

One recognition that is now widely known by Presidents is that they can request a Rotary International President's citation for a Rotarian who has served for 20 years and then each subsequent '0' year after that, i.e. 30, 40 etc. The request must be made in the Rotary year it falls and cannot be backdated, i.e. any anniversary from 1 July to 30 June must be made within that Rotary year.

It is suggested Club Presidents in their year as President request those where the date has passed in that Rotary year, and for others closer to, but before, the anniversary date.

How do I request the recognition:

- email Trudy Grice at Rotary International (RI)Parramatta Trudy.Grice@rotary.org
- Copy your AG
- Request a recognition letter from the RI President
- Give your Club, Rotarian with Rotary ID, and Anniversary Date.
- Remember it is '0' years 20 and over.
- RI in Parramatta has a template so the turn-around is not long.
- RI will copy the DG when they produce a recognition.

When presenting the recognitions, make sure it is a special occasion, such as changeover, Pride of Workmanship, formal occasion wherever possible – give due respect to the recipient and the recognition. Where possible have the DG, DGE, DGN or AG present the recognition thus adding to the prestige, but you are best to decide what the special occasion is, and who can be present to do the presentation.
